Where Do Germs Come From?

Wherever a person, place, animal, or other host where germs can live and grow, but they do not affect the host.

Germs can be found:

- in the air
- in soil, plants, and animals
- on almost any surface
- on your body

Many infectious diseases live in animals. These germs act as a reservoir of infection.

Germs that live in or on animals can infect other animals through:

- droplets
- contaminated food, soil, or water
- feces, urine, blood, or sweat
- ticks, fleas, mosquitoes, or lice that bite the animal

When an infected flea, tick, fly, mosquito, or lice bite humans, they can transmit the animal disease to them. Fortunately, most animal germs do not adapt well to living in humans.

Just a few diseases humans can get from an infected animal include:

- anthrax
- brucellosis disease
- botulism
- rabies
- salmonella
- measles

An example of a "reservoir" may be a bat or a monkey that has infectious germs living and growing in them, but they do not get sick. When these reservoir "germ" reservoir animals die, or are eaten, their germs can be passed on to other animals or humans. From the text in a "FACT-BUILD" section.

This list of early severe pandemics over the years, the more deadly ones. But outbreaks and epidemics are not uncommon. In fact, they can occur almost anywhere, at any time. All it takes is the right conditions for germs to spread.

However, as people in small housing and gathering places started to move urban centers, there was more opportunity for people and animals to interact. And so, there were more chances for germs to jump from animals to humans and cause more epidemics.

As civilization advanced, larger cities, trade across nations and seas, and more interactions between people, animals, and microorganisms created an almost constant gateway for germs, viruses, epidemics, pandemics, and pandemics.

Today we struggle with how to learn from past pandemics, implement new strategies, and respond quickly to help stop or contain them from getting away from us.

Antibodies & Antibiotics

Antibodies are the germs of a viral or bacterial in your body that recognize the same molecules when they try to attack your body. If you have antibodies to a disease, you are immune to it. You can get immunity by having the disease or by having germs in a vaccine against the disease. Antibodies are chemicals produced by one germ that take another germ by destroying or preventing it from growing.

Antibiotics can also be created in nature. Some natural antibiotics can kill a person while killing the germs that infect them.

Antibiotics are also created in laboratories. Once tested and proven to be safe, they are produced by drug companies to be sold to doctors and hospitals.

Penicillin was the first antibiotic developed in the laboratory. It was discovered by accident in 1928.

Antibiotic Advice:

- It is important not to take antibiotics for a disease that it will not work against.
- If you do get necessary for an antibiotic, be sure to take your pills—no other pills after you get better, until the pills will flow up right and you will be able to eat.

FACT-BUILD: Most people carry helpful antibodies. However, we have been exposed to the antibodies in some cases during our lives!


SCHOOLS







Amending the Constitution

Changes to the Constitution are called amendments. At the first Federal Congress in 1789, James Madison proposed to amend, or change, the original Constitution to better protect individual rights. Chief Anderson

Pilot

Have you heard the airline slogan "Fly the friendly skies"? Well, the first black man who decided he wanted to be an airline pilot found the skies very *unfriendly*. But Charles Albin "Chief" Anderson went on to earn his commercial license and train America's first black-fighter pilots. He is known as the "Father of Black Aviation."

Anderson was inspired by Charles Lindbergh's flight on the Spirit of St. Louis. The very next year, 1928, he flew his first plane. At that time a history came people did not like the idea of black pilots. Anderson had a hard time finding anyone to teach him to fly. Several people laughed with his plans, making them unable to fly.

But none of those incidents kept Anderson from pursuing his high-flying dream. Anderson finally found a man to teach him everything he needed to get a commercial pilot's license. In 1933, he made his first transcontinental flight.

Anderson got a job in Washington, D.C., teaching others to fly. He was then hired by the Tuskegee Institute in Alabama to serve as the chief instructor for its new program to train black pilots. He earned the nickname of "Chief." When First Lady Eleanor Roosevelt visited Tuskegee Institute's hospital, he took her on a flight. People saw a picture in the newspapers of the First Lady flying with Charles Anderson, and their views of black pilots began to change.

In 1941, the U.S. War Department awarded the 98th Central Postal Directory, the first all-black fighter squadron. Soon after, "Chief" Anderson was selected to be the top flight instructor for the squadron. The 98th trained with other black squadrons to form the 332nd Central Postal Directory. They were known as the " Tuskegee Army" because they had trained at Tuskegee Institute. One of their amazing accomplishments is that they did not lose one single bomber they escorted during World War II.

Lorraine Hansberry

Playwright

Lorraine Hansberry was a playwright who wrote *A Raisin in the Sun*. The 1959 drama is about a black family struggling to make a new and better life for themselves. The original Broadway play was praised by audiences and critics, and won many awards.

In 1961, a movie was made by the same title. The story focuses on a short period in the life of the Younger family. They receive an insurance check for \$10,000 and each person in the family has a special dream about how it should be spent.

Lena, the mother, wants to buy a house. Walter, the son, wants to start his own business. Younger daughter hopes to go to medical school and change the world. Walter's wife, Ruth, is caught between the dreams.







In the 1600s, King James I issued charters to begin Britain's colonization of the New World. These written documents allowed the establishment of colonies and the creation of colonial legislatures and courts. However, the colonies were not totally independent—they were under the rule and protection of Britain.

Britain and its colonies were very far apart, separated by the Atlantic Ocean. Messages, which had to be sent by boat, took months to get delivered. As a result, colonists developed their own independent governments and trade without much British control.

Britain spent a lot of time and money fighting against the French and Indians to protect its interest in the New World. The 1763 Treaty of Paris finally ended the war. King George III and Parliament decided the colonies should help Britain regain the money it spent in the war, so they passed several colonies. Goods such as tea, sugar, and paper had higher prices. They also decided that Britain needed on the colonies, so Parliament passed laws that sh legislatures, appointed royal governors, and forbidding settling west of the Appalachian Mountains.

Many colonists did not like this interference British control was unfair. Organizations such as protested against British taxation and control. "No representation" expressed one of the colonists' big Tensions grew and the colonies prepared for

- Grizzly bears are great swimmers and even better runners—grizzly bears can run across land at about 35 miles per hour. That's about as fast as a horse!
- Grizzly bears eat a LOT! When preparing for winter hibernation, grizzlies can eat up to 90 pounds of food a day!
- Unlike many animals, bears see in color, just like we do.
- Talk about terrific sniffers—grizzly bears can smell food from miles away!
- Bears are hunters, but they are also grazers. Approximately 75% of what grizzly bears eat is grass, berries, roots, and other plants. The other 25% is fish, deer, elk, rodents, honey, and even insects.
- Standing upright, a grizzly can be more than 8 feet tall!
- Some grizzlies grow to weigh more than 800 pounds!
- Biologists estimate 50,000 grizzlies once lived in the United States. Today, there are only between 1,200 and 1,400 grizzlies in the United States. It is important to protect and respect these rare, wild animals.
- Grizzly bear mothers often give birth to cubs during hibernation.
- Grizzly attacks on humans are very rare, but that does not mean grizzlies are easily tamed bears. Grizzlies are unpredictable wild animals and are best left undisturbed.

Books went from a big, thick, heavy hardcover to a book as small as a slim wallet! It was much like when we once had large telephones on a side table or a wall, until we got small, skinny, handheld cell phones. It made a big difference.

A printing press

Many creative ideas were used. Magazine presses let publishers print books "two up" and then cut them in half like a sandwich. Shorter lines of text were used so soldiers could read the book more easily. If books were not the same word count, blank pages were filled with puzzles, author biographies, and other interesting material, much to the delight of the soldier reader.


Now, the book drive felt even more urgent. Soldiers were headed out on trains and ships across the country and across the seas to fight. They would spend lonely, nervous hours clickety-clacking or splash-sloshing to their eventual posts. A book could make a soldier's probably first trip away from home more bearable.

Individuals and families carried books by hand and in boxes or grocery sacks to collection centers. Rich people piled books from their personal libraries in the back seats of their fancy cars or chauffeur-driven limousines to get them to the book bins. Celebrities, movie stars, famous singers, big bands—everyone helped announce the book drive and encourage the massive contribution of books, books, and more books.


